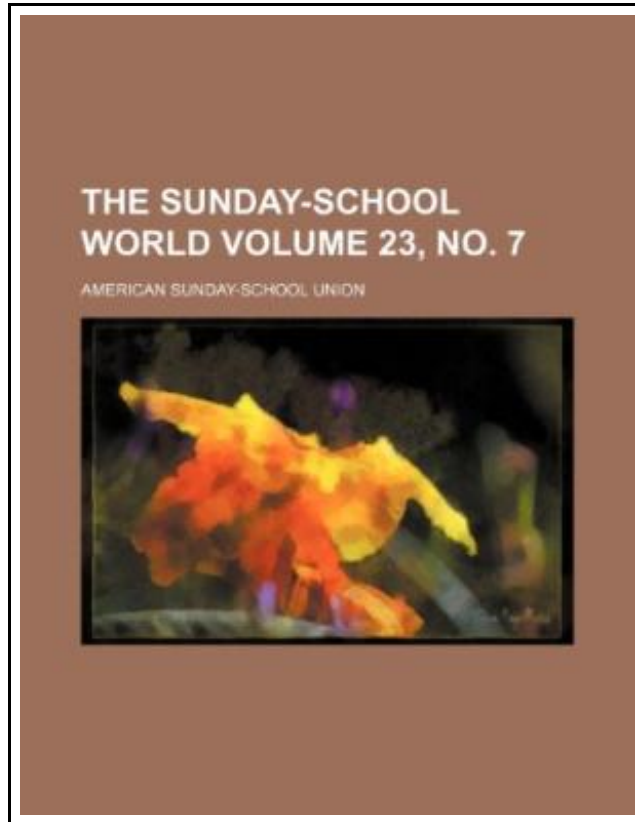

Preaching to Jews and Grecians.--Came to Corinth, v. 1. After these things refers to the discussion on Mars Hill and to its results. The journey from Athens to Corinth might have been made by land or by sea. Many writers suppose it was made by sea in a sailing vessel in winter, and that one of the shipwrecks that Paul mentions (2 Cor. 11: 25) took place on this journey. Corinth was the Vanity Fair of the world in Paul s time. Found a certain Jew named Aquila, v. 2. It is not certain that Aquila was a Christian when Paul first met him. They were of the same trade and Jews, which would bring them together. Aquila was only one of the many Jews in Corinth, for the place was important in trade and they had a synagogue. The good Jewish custom of teaching all boys a trade served Paul here. Aquila was a tent-maker, and Paul knew this trade, so they wrought together, and Paul was not dependent on gifts for a living (2 Cor. 11:9). Their history brings us into contact with the Roman emperor Claudius (whose face is found on existing coin of Corinth), who had ordered all Jews out of Rome. Pontus was the original home of Aquila, but he went where he could be employed. So Paul found him and his wife there. Tacitus, Juvenal and Cicero record the Eoman view of the Jews, of...
